

## Voice of the Parent – 2023/2024 Academic Year

## **Captured July 2024**

When analysing the 'Parent Leaver's Questionnaires' at the end of the academic year 2023/24, the following information was gathered:

- 100% of parents agreed that their child was happy at school;
- 100% of parents agreed that their child was safe at school;
- 98 % of parents agreed that they were happy with the quality of education offered at the school;
- 100% of parents agreed that their child had made progress;
- 100% of parents agreed that the school provided opportunities to discuss their child's progress and that they felt included in their child's education;
- 91% of parents agreed that the school expected their child to behave well and introduced rules and boundaries;
- 95% of parents agreed that the school was well led and managed;
- 98% of parents agreed that the team were friendly and welcoming;
- 100% of parents agreed that there was always someone available to talk to at the start or end of the day; and
- 100% of parents agreed that they would recommend Ashmore Park Nursery School to another family.
